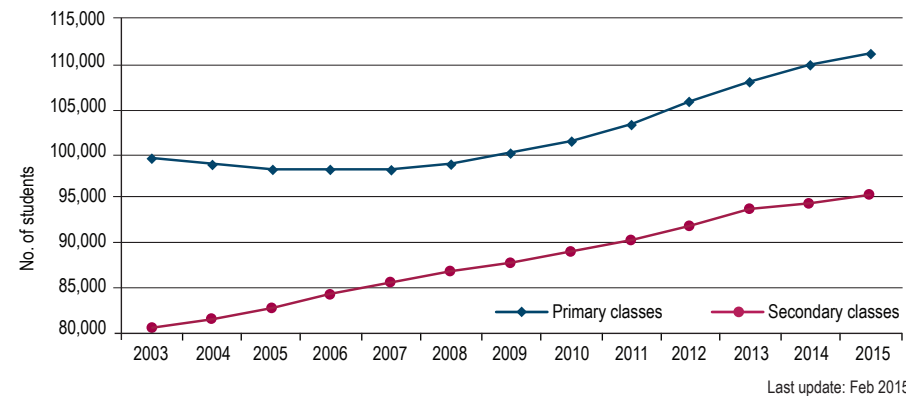

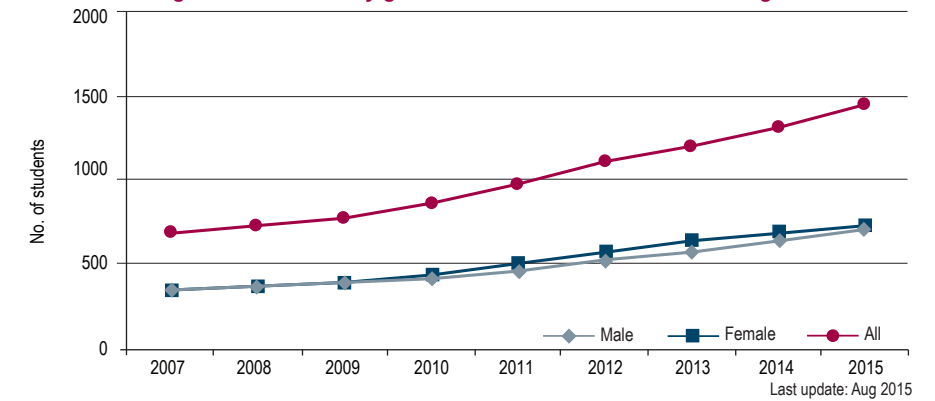

09. Number of Indigenous students, by gender, Catholic schools, Victoria, August 2007–2015



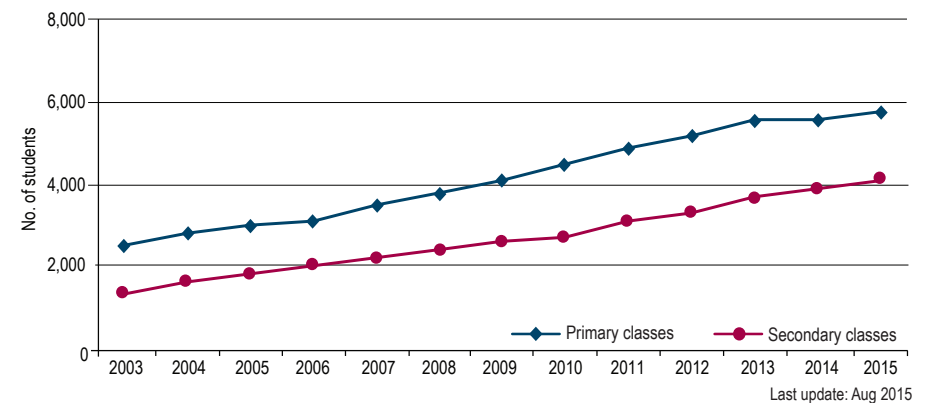

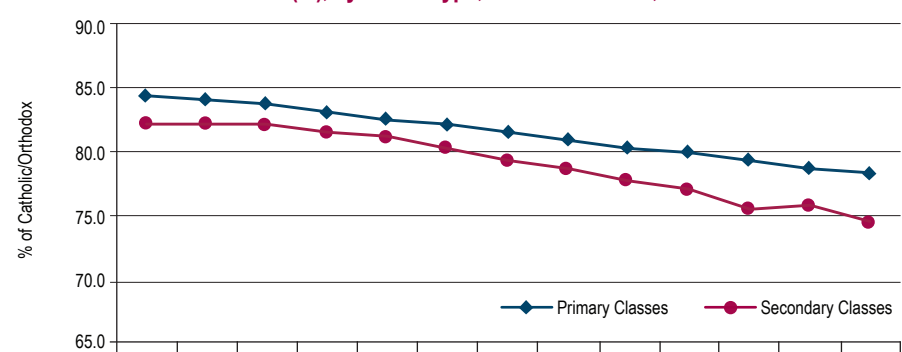

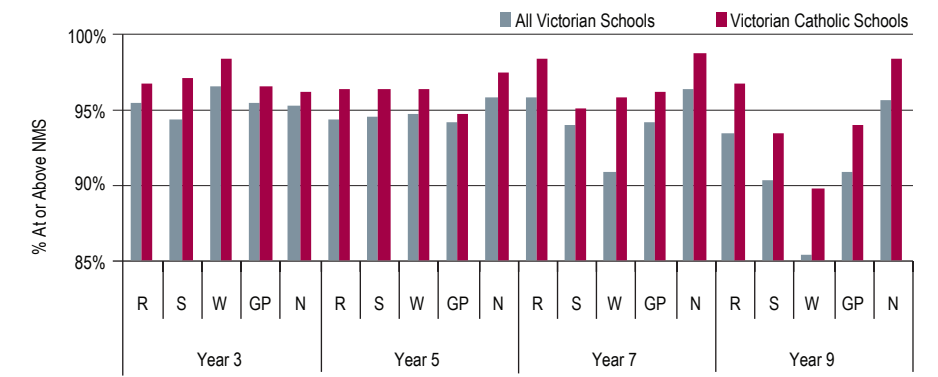

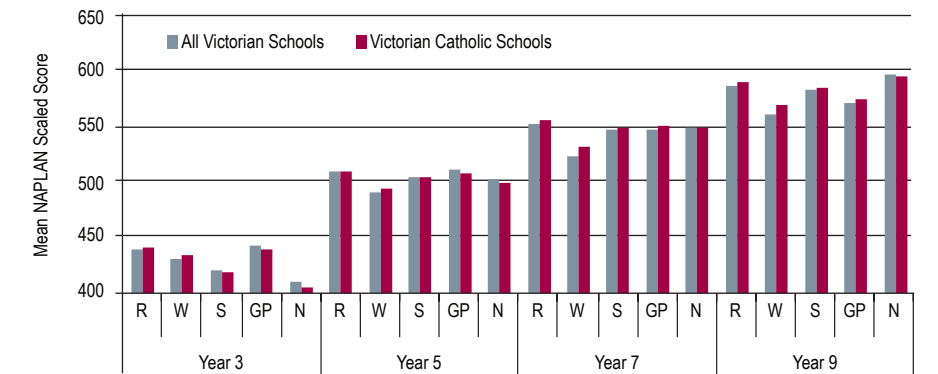
22. Students achieving National Minimum Standard (NMS) (%), All Victorian and Victorian Catholic schools, 2015
