## Circular to employees in Catholic school in Victoria and Catholic Education Offices

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### Voting for the new agreement – Employee Information

#### Main Points

- The Catholic Education Commission of Victoria Ltd (CECV) on behalf of Catholic education employers and the Independent Education Union Victoria Tasmania (IEU) have reached agreement on the proposed terms of the *Victorian Catholic Education Multi-Enterprise Agreement 2018* (VCEMEA 2018).
- The next step in the process is an employee vote to obtain approval for the proposed VCEMEA 2018.
- For the proposed VCEMEA 2018 to be approved by employees, the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth) requires that the majority of the employees of each employer (who cast a valid vote) vote in favour of the agreement. The VCEMEA 2018 can then be lodged with the Fair Work Commission for review and approval.
- The voting process for the proposed VCEMEA 2018 has been agreed between the CECV and the IEU. Voting will occur between **9.00am on Tuesday, 30 October 2018 and 1.00pm on Friday, 2 November 2018**.
