Guidance Notes for Schools

With the *Victorian Catholic Education Multi-Enterprise Agreement 2018 (VCEMEA)* commencing operation on 29 January 2019 (by agreement between the Catholic Education Commission of Victoria Ltd (**CECV**) and Independent Education Union Victoria Tasmania (**IEU**)), the CECV and IEU are reminding schools of the agreed recommended approach in relation to the following clauses:

- Personal leave deductions for teachers (clause 30.1(g)); and
- Attendance time for teachers (clause 59.1(b)).

The recommended approaches are set out in the attached Guidance Notes.

Employers should note that the Guidance Note for personal leave deductions has been updated and revised since it was issued in 2018.

The Guidance Notes provide Employers with an agreed interpretation of these matters (without prejudice to either parties' interpretations of these matters under the VCEMEA).

By agreement between the CECV and IEU, the Guidance Note for recall and end of year arrangements has been discontinued. In relation to recall and end of year attendance requirements for Category B staff, schools should refer to clauses 25.9 and 25.10 of the VCEMEA 2018
